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Introduction

At Edusoft, we are convinced that teachers are the key to successful implementation of any computerized language-learning program and as such they need to receive adequate training. Although many teachers are well trained and experienced in regular classroom delivery, the delivery of the computerized aspects of a language-learning program require additional and specific training.

Edusoft's *English Discoveries Online Teacher Training Program* is an in-depth training program designed to train both newly qualified and experienced teachers in *Blended Learning* – the integration of computer-assisted learning with teacher-led learning. Specifically, the training program focuses on the features of *English Discoveries Online* and how teachers can use them to maximize the experience of students.

The Training Program comprises a three-day schedule of sessions and an optional fourth day. The program is divided into day-long workshops which can either be given consecutively as part of an intensive course or as individual workshops spread over a longer time period. Each workshop consists of five distinct sessions, the length of which depend on the number of teachers being trained and the amount of time they are able to study each day. In general, however, it is expected that a group of 10 teachers need about one and a half hours for the first four sessions, with the final session of the day probably taking only half an hour. The optional fourth day workshop addresses the practical issues of integrating *English Discoveries Online* content with local curricula. Many institutions take advantage of Edusoft's teacher trainers during these sessions to create detailed working documents.

It should be noted that while the training program is designed to introduce teachers to working with *English Discoveries Online*, it is strongly recommend that teachers are also provided with periodic refresher workshops on integration and implementation in order to make sure that they deepen their knowledge of the program and continue working according to Edusoft's guidelines for integrating classroom and computer work.

Introductory Teacher Training Timetable

Day I:

- Familiarization of teachers with possible models of implementation
- Choice of the right model of implementation and discussion on its advantages
- Experience of an integrated lesson
- Demonstration and reflection on pre-, while-, and post-lab activities
- Discussion about the role of the teacher at four different stages in the course
- Discussion of the criteria for successfully completing the course

- Hands-on practice of the Authoring Tool
- Integration of EDO with local curriculum (Workshop)
- Development of Lesson Plans and Projects
